



ISLAM'S GLOBAL REACH

Muslims are the majority population in nearly 50 countries across Asia and Africa. Indonesia claims the largest Islamic population in the world: nearly 213 million of its 242 million people (88 percent). Pakistan, India, Bangladesh, and Egypt round out the top five largest Muslim populations.

Top 30 countries by Muslim population. Worldwide there are around 1.2 billion Muslims.


